Many of our students go on to further study and complete Masters' degrees and/or PhD

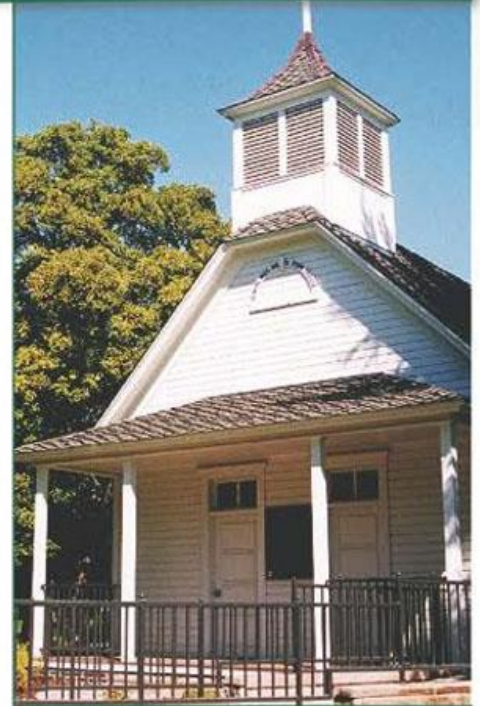
