### Why Study Children's Studies at EWU?

The curriculum of this interdisciplinary program provides a strong holistic background in the study of children, from birth to adolescence. Theory and practice, from a variety of disciplines, form the basis for this integrated curriculum. Children's studies courses provide foundational and global perspectives of children and childhood. A choice of concentration areas, culminating in a capstone experience, allows students to connect effectively with specific career opportunities. The Children's studies perspective emphasizes comprehensive studies of children's lives and respect for children's experiences.

### Is Child & Family Support for me?

Designed for students interested in assisting young children and their families in accessing early learning opportunities and providing case management services, and assisting parents in meeting the needs of their children, empowering parents in their roles as primary influencers on their children's education and development, and facilitating positive parent, school, and student relationships. Students who specialize in this option will receive a certificate in child and family support.

### Other Degree Options

Degree options or emphasis areas for a Children's Studies degree include Child Life & Health, Child Services, and Child & Family Support.

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
