Scholarship Opportunities

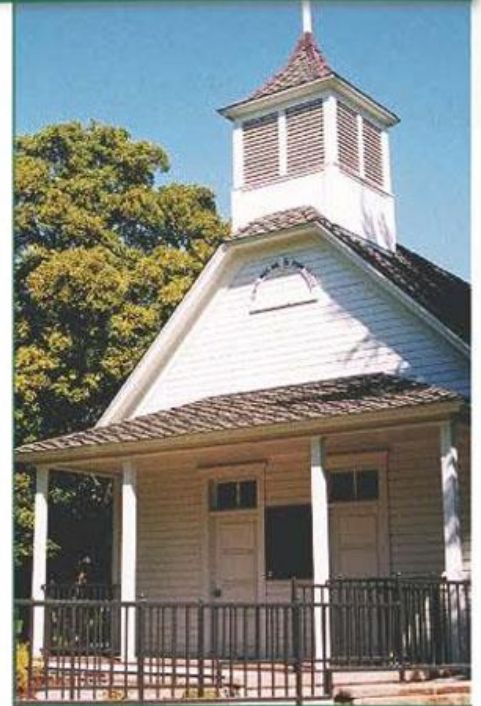
The EWU English Department offers three scholarships per year to students achieving academic excellence in their majors.
