Why study English as a Second Language?

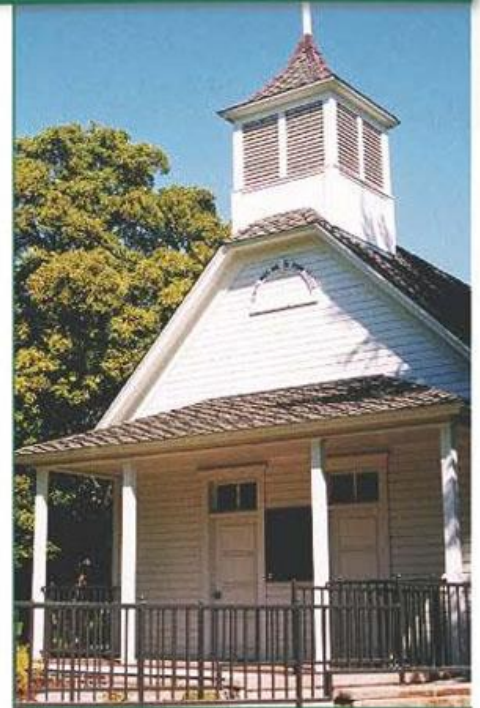
