The Modern Languages Department offers a summer program in France at the University of Nice, where EWU students and professors study the language and culture together.

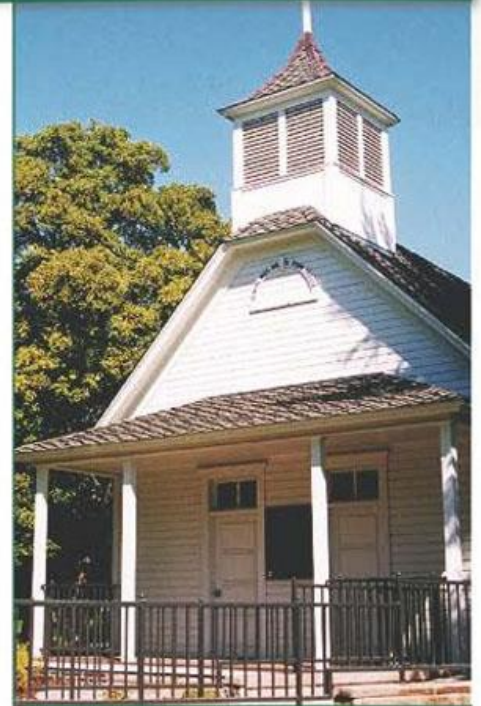

Education Program

In addition to studying the language, French Education students complete either the Elementary or Secondary Education program, which leads to certification to teach preschool – grade 12 in the State of Washington.

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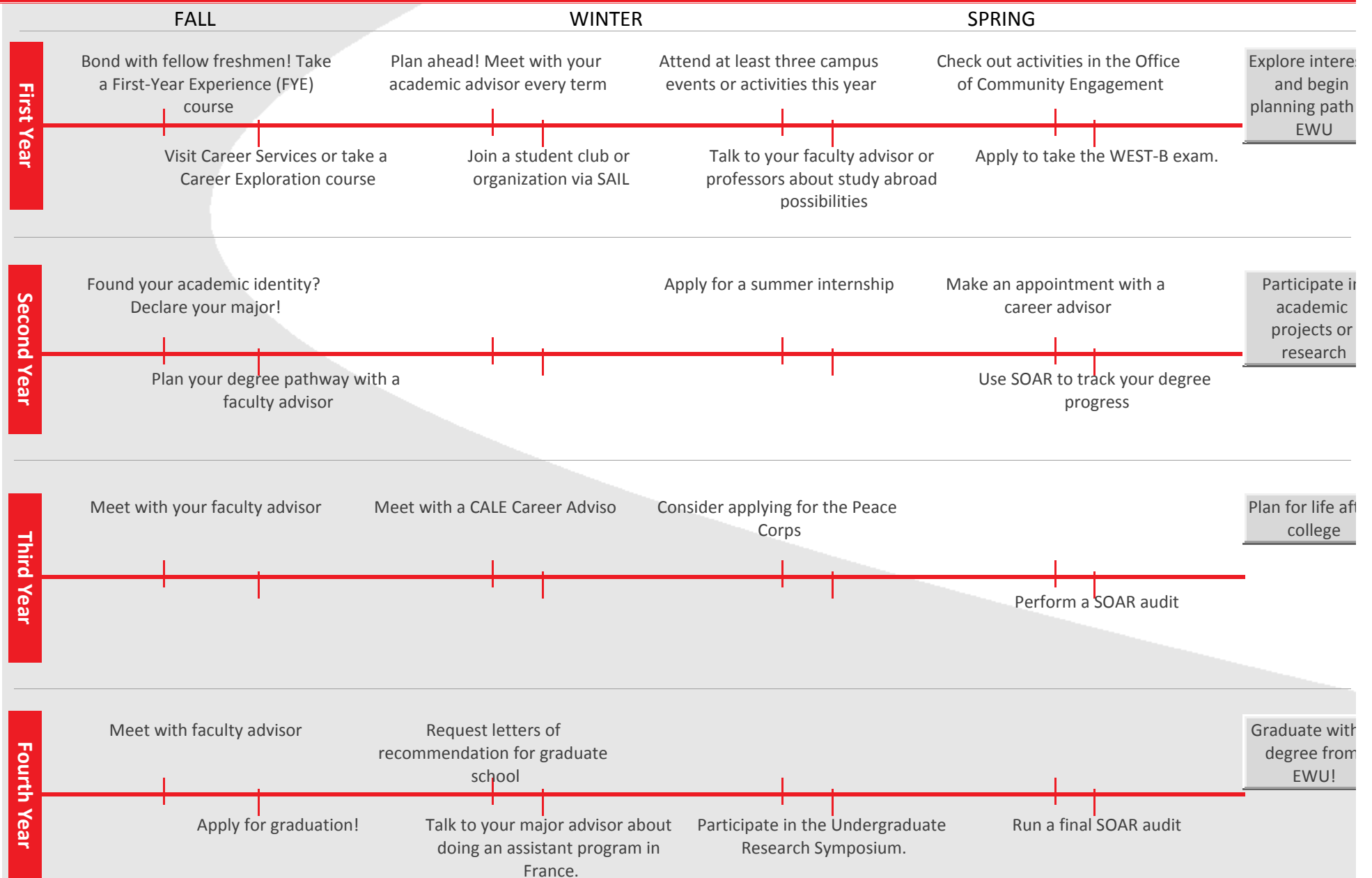
