Study Abroad Opportunities

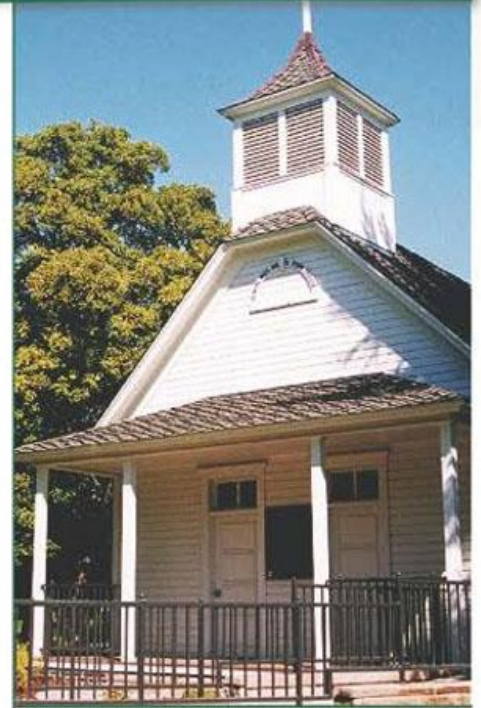
The Modern Languages Department offers a summer program in France at the University of Nice, where EWU students and professors study the language and culture together.

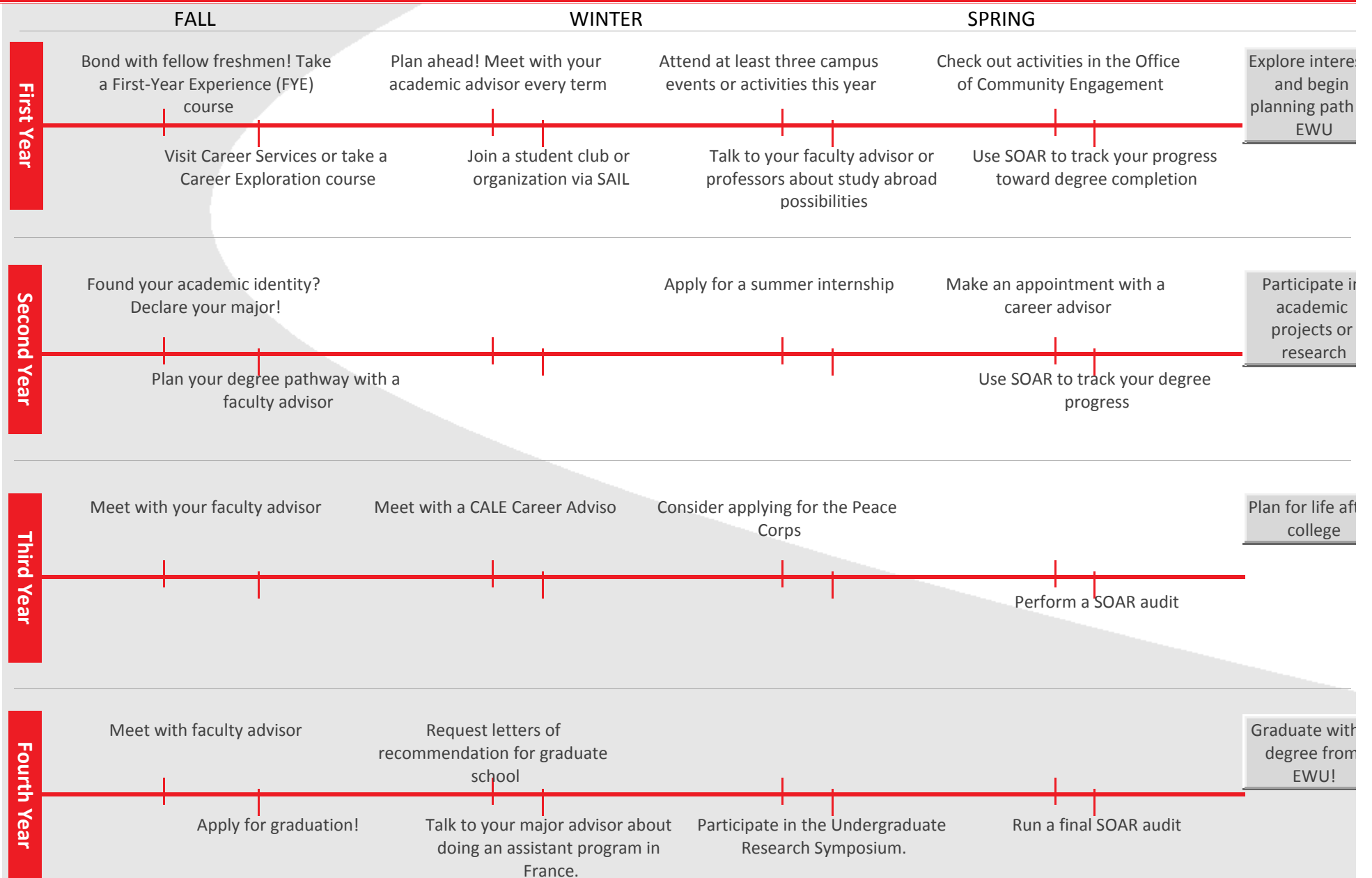
