The Modern Languages Department offers a summer program in Salamanca, Spain at the Colegio Delibes, an excellent opportunity for a first study abroad experience.

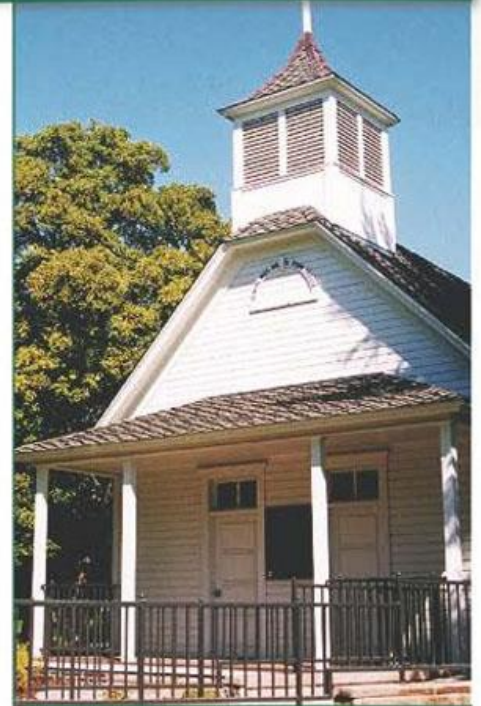
