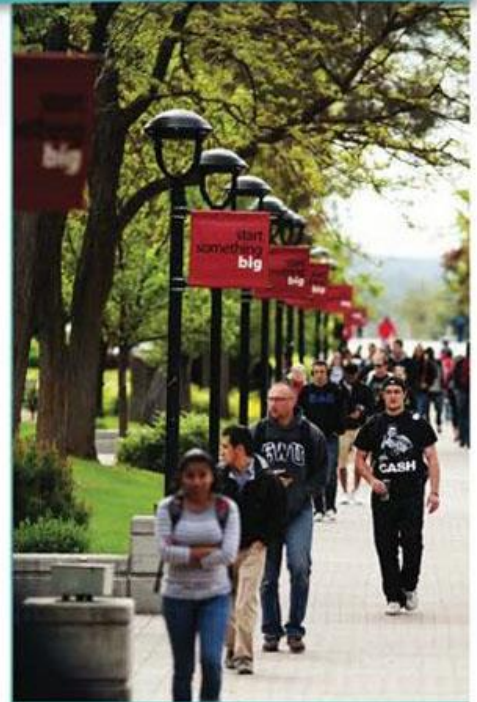
Other Degree Options

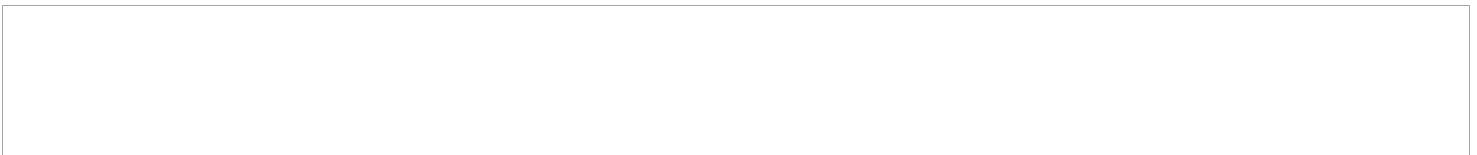

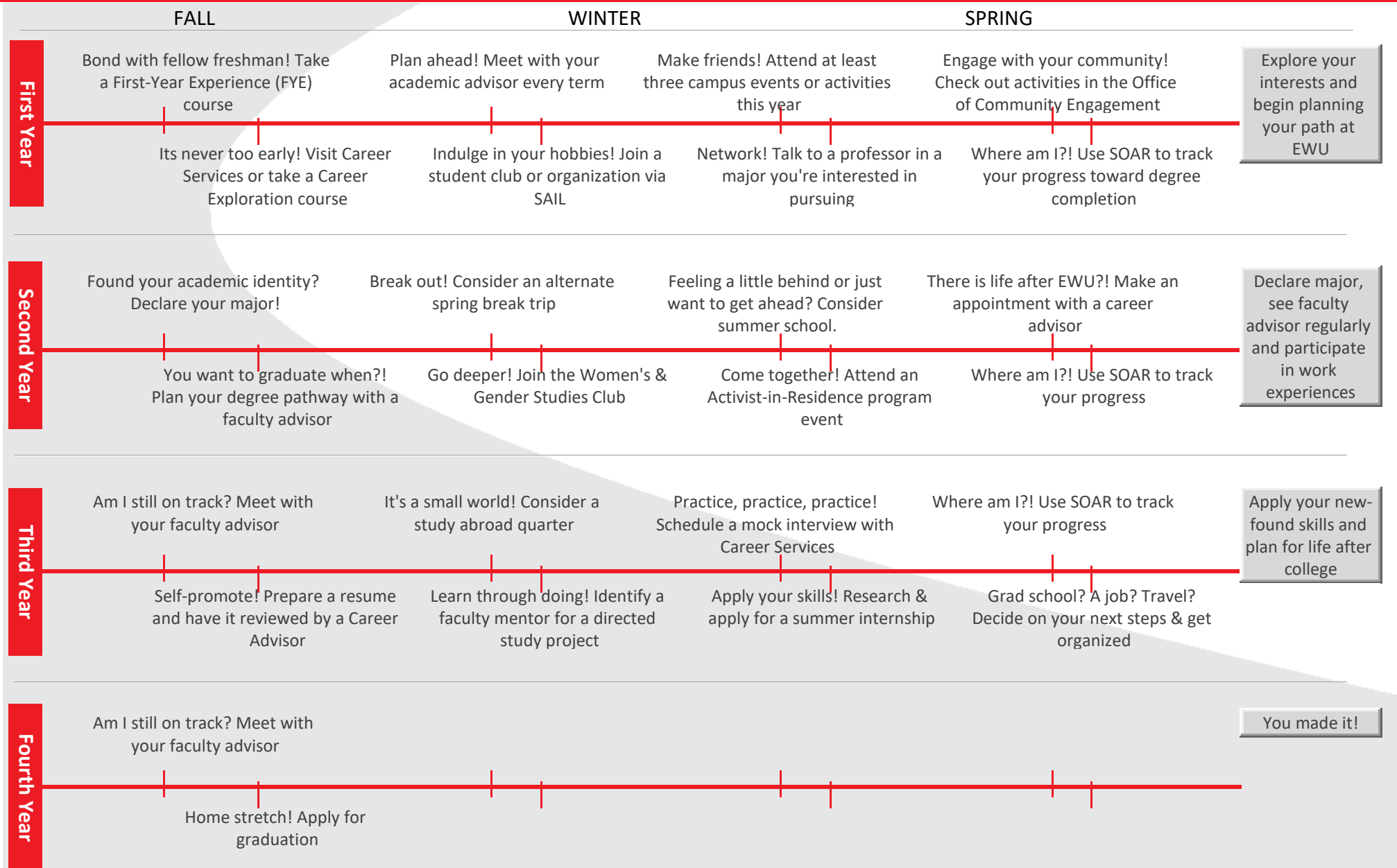
