### Why study Art History?

Art historians study items that have an aesthetic quality to them; buildings, paintings, sculptures, teapots, fabrics, glassware, temples, gargoyles, ceremonial artifacts, etc. They ask questions about the people and societies that constructed objects and investigate art's impact on society. Many of our students go on to further study and complete Masters' degrees and/or PhD Students who pursue the Bachelor of Arts degree with a major in Art History will undergo coursework in both Art History and in the studio arts to help form a well-rounded understanding of the visual arts.

### The Art Department

Our facilities include: 3-D printers, painting and drawing studios, darkroom, large-output printers, potter's wheels, digital lab, foundry, auditorium and a student installation room. We have a centralized gallery space that offers students exposure to regional artists and hands-on experience with visual display. Our Visiting Artist Lecture Series hosts public art lectures and workshops from internationally recognized artists.
