Why study Creative Writing?

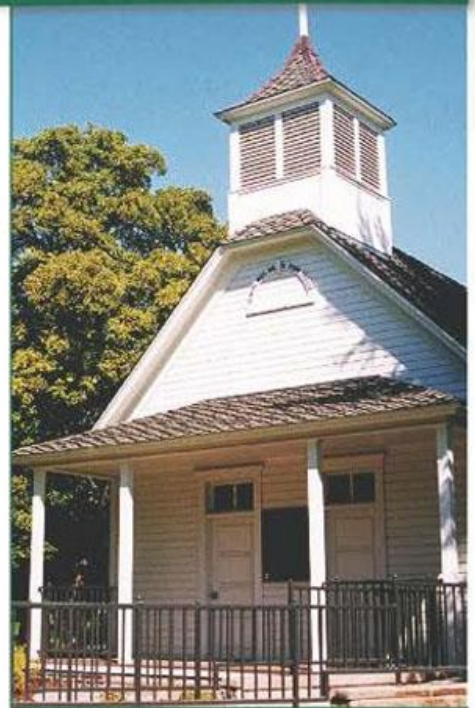
