Why study Literacy Education?

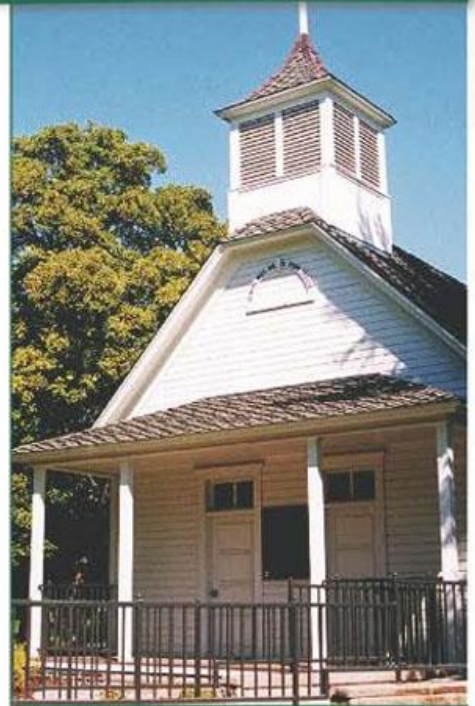
Teaching is an enormously challenging and rewarding profession. Every teacher must use his or her knowledge of the subject matter, instructional strategies, and interpersonal skills to provide learning experiences for every student in the classroom. Reading, writing, and all aspects of literacy are foundational to a child's learning. Completion of this program satisfies the State of Washington endorsement for teaching preschool - through grade 12.

Field Experiences

The purpose of field experiences is to provide the teacher candidate with direct teaching/learning experience in a school setting. The candidate has the opportunity during this time to observe teachers, plan lessons, and teach under the guidance of cooperating teachers. Student teaching is the culminating field experience when the candidate co-teaches full-time for the entire quarter.

WEST-B / WEST-E

The State of Washington requires all candidates to take the Washington Educator's Skills Test. The WEST-B, which tests basic reading, writing, and math skills, is required before admission to the Teacher Education Program.
