Why study Music?

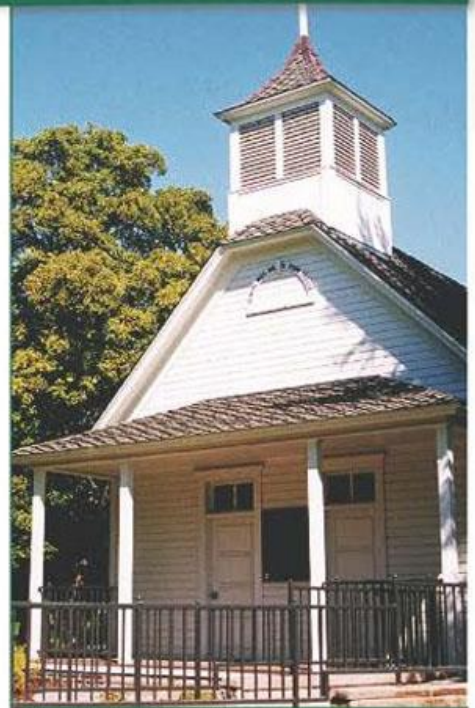
