BA in Music Technology and Entrepreneurship

This is a new Creative Multidisciplinary Convergence and Technologies (CMCT) degree currently under NASM accreditation review for approval. The curriculum requires 75 credits of courses in basic music theory, music technology, and entrepreneurship offered by three departments across three colleges. There are also 15 credits of foreign language required. The degree offers some choices with 9 credits of electives. Students get to take classes in 3-D audio, recording and mastering, sound design, designing new instruments, sonification, business planning, and start-up research to name a few. Electives can include more entrepreneurship classes, song writing, American popular music, orchestration, performing with an ensemble, or learning to play an instrument.


Why study Music Technology and Entrepreneurship?

This multidisciplinary degree seeks to create a foundation for creative and critical thinking skills related to music technology, music media production, and developing business skills so that students can carve out their own path as a music and media entrepreneur.

Students who successfully complete the BA in Music Technology and Entrepreneurship will be expected to demonstrate basic competency in music theory, to create works from music technologies, and to design sound-producing tools.

Facilities

Music students enjoy facilities featuring a state-of-the-art piano laboratory with 16 units, 32 practice rooms, a media lab with 5 digital audio workstations with Pro Tools and other software, technically-enhanced classrooms, and an extensive collection of recordings, scores, and music reference materials located in the JFK library. The music building houses a renovated 250-seat capacity recital hall and Showalter Hall serves as an additional performance venue on campus.
