#### ACTFL

Candidates must pass the following Spanish proficiency tests at the Advanced-Low level:

ACTFL Writing Proficiency Test (WPT)

ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI)

The **WEST-E** Designated world languages is taken prior to certification.

#### WEST-B

The State of Washington requires all candidates to take and pass the Washington Educator's Skills Test. The WEST-B, which tests basic reading, writing, and math skills, is required before admission to the Teacher Education Program. Satisfactory SAT or ACT scores may waive all or part of the WEST-B test.
