### Why study Art?

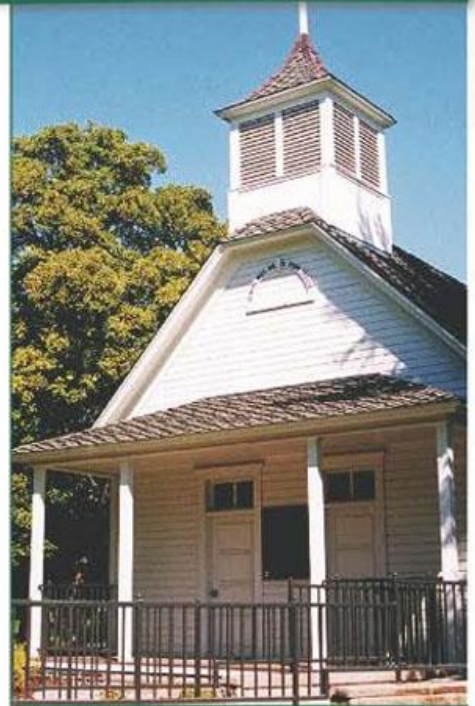
Art represents people, cultures, values and perspectives on being human. Studying art gives students the tools to interpret the world in which they live by cultivating and awakening the imagination in themselves and others. The skills gained through our art programs, such as problem-solving, critical thinking, and creative enterprise, intersect with all disciplines and help develop abilities needed to excel in a variety of careers in and outside the field of art. BFA students pursue studio concentrations in painting, drawing, printmaking, ceramics, sculpture, intermedia, photography, and/or hybrid practices. The Bachelor of Fine Arts degree is the professional pathway program for entrance into graduate-level art schools and/or professional studio practices.

### The Art Department

Our facilities include: 3-D printers, painting and drawing studios, darkroom, large-output printers, potter's wheels, digital lab, foundry, auditorium and a student installation room. We have a centralized gallery space that offers students exposure to regional artists and hands-on experience with visual display. Our Visiting Artist Lecture Series hosts public art lectures and workshops from internationally recognized artists.
