As an art teacher, you will have a unique platform to help foster elevated emotional, academic, and social well-being in society. Eastern Washington University's outstanding art education program strives to produce effective teachers who are working artists. BAE students pursue studio concentrations in painting, drawing, printmaking, ceramics, sculpture, photography, and/or hybrid practice. In addition to studying art, Bachelor of Art Education (BAE) students complete the Secondary Education program, which leads to certification to teach grades preschool-12 in the State of Washington.

The Art Department

Our facilities include: 3-D printers, painting and drawing studios, darkroom, large-output printers, potter's wheels, digital lab, foundry, auditorium and a student installation room. We have a centralized gallery space that offers students exposure to regional artists and hands-on experience with visual display. Our Visiting Artist Lecture Series hosts public art lectures and workshops from internationally recognized artists.
