# The Undergraduate Degree

## Graduation Requirements

Requirements for the baccalaureate degree at EWU are the following:

### Credit Requirement Minimums

- 180 cumulative college-level credit hours
- 60 upper-division credits (300- and 400-level coursework)
- 45 credits in residence (attendance) at EWU, with at least 15 upper-division credits in the major in residence at EWU

### 2.0 Cumulative GPA Minimum

- For all EWU coursework
- For all Breadth Area Core Requirements (BACRs) and University Graduation Requirements
- In major programs, subject to departmental requirements

## Class Standing

Class standing is based on **completed** college level credits. Classes you are currently enrolled in are **NOT** included. Registration priority is also determined by **completed** credits.



Freshmen (< 45 credits) are required to meet quarterly with an advisor. Undeclared Juniors (≥ 90 credits) need to connect with an advisor to discuss declaring a major.

## University Competencies & Proficiencies

Students must earn at least a C grade minimum in all mathematics and English composition courses to pass.

## EWU General Education Requirements

General Education requirements needed to graduate from EWU include:

### University Competencies & Proficiencies (C/P)

- English Composition
- Quantitative & Symbolic Reasoning (Math)

### Breadth Area Core Requirements (BACR) - 2 each :

- Humanities/Arts
- Social Science
- Natural Science

### University Graduation Requirements (UGR) - 1 each:

- Diversity
- Global Studies
- Foreign Language (1 year if required for student)
- Senior Capstone

**Transfer students** with **Direct Transfer Agreement (DTA)** degree have C/P and BACR requirements cleared; check with CAAR/major department to determine all other completed general education requirements.

Transfer students **without** a Bachelor's degree or Associate-DTA degree must have their transcripts evaluated by the transcript evaluation team to determine which, if any, General Education Requirements have been satisfied.

	Students must complete required PUBS courses prior to earning 45 credits (sophomore standing). PUBS do not count as college credit, nor are they included in your term or cumulative GPA.
