

### Examples of Action Steps to Improve Student Learning Outcomes

- Change curricular design and sequencing
- Add or delete course(s)
- Restrict how students may navigate through the curriculum
- Weave more of “x” across the curriculum
- Add prerequisites
- Modify frequency or schedule of course offerings
- Reduce class size
- Add activities to teaching inventory
- Put in place formal mechanisms for strengthening communication among instructors about the need to prepare students to meet course and program learning outcomes
- Widely share learning expectations with students
- Change course content or assignments
- Devote resources to faculty teaching development activities
- Increase remediation opportunities for students
- Provide student support structures such as tutoring or help sessions
- Create learning modules or self-paced learning experiences to address typical learning obstacles
- Bolster program infrastructure
- Enhance advising by revising departmental advising standards or processes
- Revise criteria for admission to the program
