



THE KRUMBLE FOUNDATION INTERNSHIP STIPEND PROGRAM

The Krumble Foundation Internship Stipend Program is designed to encourage and support outstanding students who are interested in pursuing an unpaid internship at non-profit or governmental agency. Students can apply for a stipend of up to \$3000 to help alleviate any financial barriers that's preventing them from pursuing an internship (flight cost, housing cost, etc). To apply for the stipend, students must meet the following criteria:

- Be a full-time student
- Be a junior or senior in credit standing
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better
- Have an internship in a non-profit or governmental agency
- Must be an unpaid internship
- Be receiving academic credit for your internship
- Work with the faculty internship advisor within your major

How to get started:

Work with the EWU Internship Coordinator at the Career Center for assistance on how to find an internship. Once you are in the process of securing an internship, complete the application for the Krumble Foundation Internship Stipend. You can find the application by going to [inside.ewu.edu/careercenter/](#), picking up a physical copy at the Career Center in PUB 332, or email the internship coordinator directly (see below).

In order to apply for the stipend, the following materials must be submitted to us by **Monday, December 6, 2021**. Application review and final recipient selection will be conducted by the Career Center, and the recipients will be contacted by **Wednesday, December 22, 2021**. Students must turn in the following documents to be eligible:

1. The signed application form (next page).
2. Attach your 1-2 page essay to the application outlining:
 - a) *“Why this internship is essential to your professional development goals, and how will this stipend support that?”*
 - b) Include your desired company in your essay, and why you would like to intern there.
 - c) See the attached grading rubric to know
