

Course Syllabus Statements

The Equal Opportunity and Affirmative Action Office and Disability Support Services encourage faculty members to inform students of their intent to provide reasonable program modifications to them. This notice invites students to initiate the modification process in a respectful and effective way. We recommend that instructors include one of the following statements in their course syllabi. In addition to a written statement, we recommend that instructors announce their intent to provide reasonable modifications on the first day of class.

Option 1: Students with disabilities may request reasonable modifications by contacting me. Eastern Washington University assures equal access to instruction through collaboration between students with disabilities, instructors, and Disability Support Services. "Reasonable" means the University permits no fundamental alterations of academic standards or retroactive modifications.

Option 2: Eastern Washington University assures equal access to instruction through collaboration between students with disabilities, instructors, and Disability Support Services. If you think you may have a disability adversely affecting your academic performance, and you have not already registered with Disability Support Services, please contact Disability Support Services in 121 Tawanka or call 509.359.6871. I will work with you and Disability Support Services to provide an appropriate modification.
