## EWU SCHOOL of EDUCATION internships at-a-glance

- 1. Internships are NOT offered during summer session.
- 2. All internship courses are Pass/Fail.
- 3. Principal Certification Students see specific internship worksheet for details the following instructions do not apply to you.
- 4. It is recommended that students complete their internship after having completed their first or second sessions, so they will have some coursework to use in the experience.
- 5. Some programs' internship courses have prerequisites, so make sure to complete those first. For example: Health & Physical Education require Health Basics before the Health internship.
- 6. Students are responsible for securing their own internship placement. Make sure to check your program's internship placement requirements before contacting the site.
- 7. Early Childhood and Literacy Graduate students <u>do not need</u> to complete an internship verification form because their internships are not at external sites.
- 8. <u>All programs except Early Childhood and Literacy:</u> Should complete the EWU online <u>Internship Verification (ewu.edu)</u>. Your internship faculty reserves the right to ask you to find a new internship. We have built in the Build Verification form to the Intern form, so your mentor and principal will be notified via email for approval.
- 9. Enroll in your internship course on EagleNet.
- 10. You are <u>not required</u> to resubmit your internship site application and building forms for consecutive internship courses at the same internship site. If you switch internship sites, you must submit a new verification and building form.
