

Commute Trip Reduction Program

What you need to know

The Commute Trip Reduction Program is a state-wide effort to reduce air pollution generated by automobiles by cutting down the number of automobiles being driven to work with only one person in them (single occupancy vehicle).

This goal is accomplished by encouraging alternate modes of transportation such as carpooling, bus riding, walking, bicycling, vanpooling and telecommuting, and by making participation in CTR fun.

Employees may be eligible for a free or reduced cost bus pass. Additionally, there are awards and incentives for CTR participation.
