

EWU Alert System & SNOW Line

What you need to know

EWU Alerts is a notification system via text messaging in the event of an emergency or campus safety situation.



During an emergency situation, EWU Alerts is the quickest way for you to find out information to keep yourself safe.

In the past 15 years, EWU Alerts has been activated for campus closures due to excessive snow fall, one incident of a suspected bomb, as well as other incidents affecting a single building.
