1 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING 2 3 THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING SETS FORTH THE FOLLOWING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE WASHINGTON FEDERATION OF STATE EMPLOYEES 4 5 LOCAL 931 (THE "UNION") AND EASTERN WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY (THE 6 "UNIVERSITY") PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 5 OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT (CBA) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2017. 7 8 9 10 The parties agree that: 11 1. Article 5, Union Membership and Dues, of the 2017-2019 CBA will be modified as follows: 12 13 14 ARTICLE 5 – UNION MEMBERSHIP AND DUES DEDUCTION 15 16 Union Membership. 17 Agency Shop. Subject to the provisions of this Article, employees who are 18 5.1.1 members of the Union as of the effective date of this Agreement will remain 19 members in good standing for the term of the Agreement. Any employee 20 who, as of the effective date of this Agreement is not a member of the 21 Union, and any employee hired after the effective date of this Agreement 22 will, within thirty (30) days become and remain a member of the Union. In 23 the event any employee wishes to withdraw from the Union, or does not 24 wish to become a member of the Union, the employee will have the right to 25 decline membership in the Union under the following circumstances: 26 27 28 In accordance with RCW 41.80.100, an employee who asserts a right of non-association based on bona fide religious tenets or the 29 teachings of a religious body of which the employee is a member will 30 pay to the Union an amount of money equal to regular dues, which 31 the Union will either use for purposes that are in harmony with the 32 employee's individual conscience or provide to a nonreligious 33 34 charity. 35 36 If an Employee for reasons other than religious belief does not wish to be a member of the Union, that employee will proportionately and 37 fairly share in the cost of the collective bargaining process by paying 38 39 to the Union a representation fee. The representation fee will be fixed at the amount of dues and initiation fees uniformly required of 40 each member of the bargaining unit to defray the cost of services 41 42 rendered by the Union in negotiating and administering this Agreement as provided by RCW 41.80.100(1). 43 44 45 Compliance. In the event an employee fails to meet the requirements set 5.1.2

forth in Section 5.1.1, the Union will give the University a reminder of this

fact, with a copy to the employee. The employee will comply within thirty

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amount and ongoing monthly deduction amount. Authorizations may be

revoked by the employee at any time by giving written notice to both the University and the Union. The University agrees to remit electronically,

10	the first payroll, and not later than the second payroll, after receipt by the University of		
11	confirmation from the Union that the terms of the employee's signed membership card

14	5.5	Indemnification and Hold Harmless Th	e Union agrees to indemnify and save hold the
15	5.5 <u>Indemnification and Hold Harmless</u> . The Union agrees to indemnify and save <u>hold</u> the University harmless against any liability which may arise by reason of any action		
16	taken by the University to comply with the provisions of this article, including		
17	reimbursement for any legal fees or expenses incurred in connection such action. The
