Some state employees may qualify for health care coverage through the [Washington Apple Health program](#) at no cost, or [Washington Apple Health for Kids with premiums](#). If you would like to see if you or your dependents qualify for coverage you may apply online at www.wahealthplanfinder.org, or by contacting the Health Benefit Exchange Customer Support Center at 1-855-923-4633. If you want to take advantage of this opportunity, I urge you to seek additional information as quickly as possible.

If you or your dependents qualify for no-cost Washington Apple Health, you will have a choice of available managed care plans depending on the county in which you live. There are no premiums, co-pays, or deductibles. If your dependents qualify for Washington Apple Health for Kids with premiums and you choose to enroll, you will be responsible to pay a small monthly premium.

You may also choose to keep your insurance through your employer. If you keep your employer-based coverage you may qualify for help with your insurance premiums.
