 - a) Intramurals- Student Affairs- \$151,545.00
 - i) 6% cut of last year's request would be \$147,167
 - **ii)** \$86,000 is for wages
 - iii) Option to keep at \$151,000
 - iv) Option to keep request at same
 - v) A motion was made to move forward with budget of \$151,000; 5-0-0
 - b) Multicultural Center- \$50,000

- c) Music Department- \$78,000
 - i) 6% cut from previous year's request would be \$29,109
 - ii) Option: \$15,000 go specifically to music department
 - iii) A motion to approve for \$15,000 for music department; 5-1-0
 - iv) Marching band and music department is \$125,000
- d) Marching Band
 - i) A motion was made for \$15,000 for the marching band at 0% increase; 5-0-0
- e) Office of Community Engagement- \$11,225
