- 3. Student union fee- maintenance fee (debt services)
 - a. \$65/quarter (Fall 2018-\$85/quarter)
 - b. Debt service
- 4. Transportation fee- Spokane Transit for students
 - \$20/quarter to students in service area (i.e. not Bellevue campus)
 - b. Student fee funds STA contract 50%
- ii. S & A Fee- General \$653 Funds ASEWU
 - 1. 3.5% goes into financial aid- EWU Grant
 - 2. Draws for Debt Service
 - a. PUB & transfer to H & D for Debt
 - 3. Remaining Funds for SA Committee
- iii. 5% estimated increase, distribution different in FY 2107 & FY 2018
 - 1. \$13.6M total uses that are estimated FY2018
 - 2. \$12.3M total uses that are estimated FY2017
- c. Other
 - i. Total distributed to spend: about \$5.6M
 - ii. When departments come to ask for money
 - 1. Extra money will come out of S&A reserve for year 2017
 - iii. Bond expectations to Housing (for example) we cannot change the amount we give.
 - iv. We can only increase S&A fee not related to payment of debt.
 - v. Minimum Wage- talk about at next meeting
 - 1. Ask for supplemental wage increase possible from departments
 - vi. Fees benefitting Spokane Campus (18% of population located here)
 - 1. What percentage of proposal funding is benefitting them?
 - 2. Idea to create a goal of a certain percent of funding goes to Spokane Campus.
